A bill to be entitled

An act relating to student assessment; creating s. 1008.255, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to adopt grade-placement assessments for grades 1 through 8 to determine grade placement for a student previously enrolled in a private school, a parochial, religious, or denominational school, a home education program, or a private tutoring program; requiring school districts to administer the assessments; providing for the use of assessments; providing parent responsibility; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1008.255, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1008.255 Grade-placement assessments.-

(1) The Department of Education shall adopt gradeplacement assessments for grades 1 through 8 to determine the
grade placement of a student enrolling in a public school who
was enrolled the prior school year in a private school, a
parochial, religious, or denominational school, a home education
program, or a private tutoring program.

(2) Each school district shall administer the gradeplacement assessment to a student enrolling in a public school
in the district prior to grade placement. A grade-placement
assessment shall provide objective data on the student's
performance based on performance standards approved by the State

- (3) The parent of a student who is enrolling in a public school pursuant to this section must permit his or her child to be assessed for grade placement regardless of the date of enrollment in the school year.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
