6 Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section
7 379.3511, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

8 379.3511 Appointment of subagents for the sale of hunting,
9 fishing, and trapping licenses and permits.—

10 (1) Subagents shall serve at the pleasure of the
11 commission. The commission may establish, by rule, procedures
12 for the selection and appointment of subagents. The following

13 are requirements for subagents so appointed:

14 (e) A subagent may charge and receive as his or her
15 compensation 50 cents for each license or permit sold. This
16 charge is in addition to the sum required by law to be collected
17 for the sale and issuance of each license or permit. This charge
18 does not apply to the shoreline fishing license; however, for
19 each shoreline fishing license issued, the subagent may retain
20 50 cents from other license proceeds otherwise due the
21 commission.

22 Section 2. Subsection (5) of section 379.352, Florida
23 Statutes, is amended to read:

24 379.352 Recreational licenses, permits, and authorization
25 numbers to take wild animal life, freshwater aquatic life, and
26 marine life; issuance; costs; reporting.-

27 (5) In addition to any license or permit fee, the sum of
28 \$1.50 shall be charged for each license or management area
29 permit, except for replacement licenses, to cover the cost of
30 issuing such license or permit. This charge does not apply to
31 the shoreline fishing license; however, for each shoreline
32 fishing license issued, the tax collector may retain 50 cents
33 from other license proceeds otherwise due the commission.

34 Section 3. Paragraph (k) of subsection (4) of section
35 379.354, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

38 (4) RESIDENT HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES.-The licenses and
