6 Section 1. (1) An environmental surcharge is imposed on
7 each bottle of water sold in the amount of 6 percent of the
8 sales price of each item, article, or group of items of or
9 containing bottled water when sold at retail in this state.

10 (2) All moneys collected from the surcharge levied under
11 this section shall be deposited into the Ecosystem Management
12 and Restoration Trust Fund within the Department of
13 Environmental Protection.

15 administered, collected, and enforced in the same manner as the
16 tax imposed under s. 212.05.
