Section 4. Section 828.28, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

828.28 Local animal licensing ordinances; notices.-

(1) Any county or municipality that has a licensing requirement for dogs must provide notice to dog owners at least 45 days prior to any licensure renewal deadline. The notice must contain information describing the licensing requirements and any associated penalties. Failure to receive the notice does not relieve the owner of their responsibilities under the local
