Section 4. Section 828.28, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

828.28 Local animal licensing ordinances; notices.-

(1) Any county or municipality that has a licensing requirement for dogs must provide notice to dog owners at least 45 days prior to any licensure renewal deadline. The notice must contain information describing the licensing requirements and any associated penalties. Failure to receive the notice does not relieve the owner of their responsibilities under the local



licensing ordinance.

(2) Counties and municipalities with licensing requirements are encouraged to develop online licensing systems to provide a convenient and cost effective licensing process.

An act relating to animal control; providing a short title; amending s. 500.451, F.S.; prohibiting specified acts relating to horsemeat for human consumption; providing penalties; increasing the classification of offenses relating to horsemeat for human consumption; providing for suspension of licenses of certain businesses for offenses relating to horsemeat; providing mandatory minimum penalties; amending s. 828.125, F.S.; revising provisions prohibiting certain acts relating to horses to apply to all horses regardless of breed; providing mandatory minimum penalties; creating s. 828.28, F.S.; requiring local governments to provide notice prior to licensing deadlines; encouraging local governments to develop online licensing systems; providing an effective date.
