**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 28 and 29  
insert:

Section 2. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (6) of  
section 290.0055, Florida Statutes, to read:

290.0055 Local nominating procedure.—

(6)

(d)1. The governing body of a jurisdiction which nominated  
the application for an enterprise zone that includes a portion  
of the state designated as a rural area of critical economic  
concern pursuant to s. 288.0656(7) may apply to the Office of

13 Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to expand the boundary  
14 of the enterprise zone by not more than 3 square miles. Such  
15 application must be submitted by December 31, 2011.

16 2. Notwithstanding the area limitations specified in  
17 subsection (4), the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic  
18 Development may approve the request for a boundary amendment if  
19 the area continues to satisfy the remaining requirements of this  
20 section.

21 3. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development  
22 shall establish the initial effective date of an enterprise zone  
23 designated under this paragraph.

24 Section 3. Section 290.00727, Florida Statutes, is created  
25 to read:

26 290.00727 Enterprise zone designation for Martin County.-  
27 Martin County may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and  
28 Economic Development for designation of one enterprise zone for  
29 an area within Martin County, which zone shall encompass an area  
30 up to 10 square miles consisting of land within the primary  
31 urban services boundary and focusing on Indiantown, but  
32 excluding property owned by Florida Power and Light to the west,  
33 two areas to the north designated as estate residential, and the  
34 county-owned Timer Powers Recreational Area. Within the  
35 designated enterprise zone, Martin County shall exempt  
36 residential condominiums from benefiting from state enterprise  
37 zone incentives, unless prohibited by law. The application must  
38 be submitted by December 31, 2010, and must comply with the  
39 requirements of s. 290.0055. Notwithstanding s. 290.0065  
40 limiting the total number of enterprise zones designated and the  
41 number of enterprise zones within a population category, the

42 Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may designate  
43 one enterprise zone under this section. The Office of Tourism,  
44 Trade, and Economic Development shall establish the initial  
45 effective date of the enterprise zone designated pursuant to  
46 this section.
