- Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 25.073, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 25.073 Retired justices or judges assigned to temporary duty; additional compensation; appropriation.--
- (1) For purposes of this section, the term "retired justice" or "retired judge" means any former justice or judge who is not engaged in the practice of law and either:
- (a) Has failed to win reelection or be retained after more than 12 years of service as a justice or judge; or not been defeated in seeking reelection to, or has not failed to be retained in seeking retention in, his or her last judicial office or was not defeated when last seeking election to judicial office; and
- (b) <u>Has served at least one complete term as a justice or judge and chose not to stand for retention or reelection at the conclusion of the latest term is not engaged in the practice of law.</u>
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
