Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 637.1028, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

637.1028 Title Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund.-

- (1) The Title Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund is created within the Division of Title Insurance of the Department of Financial Services. All fees and charges collected from title insurers and title insurance agents and agencies pursuant to s. 637.2031 shall be deposited in the Title Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund and shall be used for the sole purpose of carrying out the responsibilities of the Division of Title Insurance.
- (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund and be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.
- (3) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State
 Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be
