25 WHEREAS, the final mission of the Apollo space program was
26 launched on July 15, 1975, from the John F. Kennedy Space Center
27 in Cape Canaveral, Florida, and

28 WHEREAS, during the interim between the Apollo and Space
29 Shuttle programs, the Space Shuttle program had to establish, at
30 great expense, a new and untested workforce for Space Shuttle
31 flight operations, and

32 WHEREAS, the first orbital flight of the Space Shuttle was
33 launched on April 12, 1981, from the John F. Kennedy Space
34 Center, and

35 WHEREAS, the final mission of the Space Shuttle program is
36 scheduled for launch on September 16, 2010, and

37 WHEREAS, the first manned flight of the Orion spacecraft,
38 the planned successor of the Space Shuttle, was not scheduled
39 for launch until 2015, and

40 WHEREAS, on February 1, 2010, the President of the United
41 States announced a proposal to cancel funding for the
42 Constellation program, including the Orion spacecraft, NOW,
43 THEREFORE,
