Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 51 and 52

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 320.61, Florida Statutes,
is amended to read:

320.61 Licenses required of motor vehicle manufacturers,
distributors, importers, etc.—

(2) The department may prescribe an abbreviated application
for renewal of a license if the licensee had previously filed an
initial application pursuant to s. 320.63. The application for
renewal shall include any information necessary to bring current
the information required in the initial application. The

14 department may not renew any license unless the licensee
15 complies with the provisions of s. 320.63.

16 Section 3. Present subsection (7) of section 320.63,
17 Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (8), and a new
18 subsection (7) is added to that section, to read:

19 320.63 Application for license; contents.—Any person
20 desiring to be licensed pursuant to ss. 320.60-320.70 shall make
21 application therefor to the department upon a form containing
22 such information as the department requires. The department
23 shall require, with such application or otherwise and from time
24 to time, all of the following, which information may be
25 considered by the department in determining the fitness of the
26 applicant or licensee to engage in the business for which the
27 applicant or licensee desires to be licensed:

28 (7) Upon annual renewal of its license, an affidavit
29 acknowledging that the terms or provisions of the licensee's
30 franchise agreements with motor vehicle dealers in this state
31 are consistent with and not prohibited by ss. 320.60-320.70, and
32 rules adopted thereunder, which are in effect. Any provision in
33 such agreements which is inconsistent with or prohibited by such
34 laws or rules is void.

61 agreements are consistent with the requirements of
62 laws and rules; providing an effective date.
