29	school district may prorate all teacher bonuses proportionately
30	to the total funds available.
31	(n) Calculation of additional full-time equivalent
32	membership based on Advanced International Certificate of
33	Education examination scores of studentsA value of 0.16 full-
34	time equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each
35	student enrolled in a full-credit Advanced International
36	Certificate of Education course who receives a score of E or
37	higher on a subject examination. A value of 0.08 full-time
38	equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each
39	student enrolled in a half-credit Advanced International
40	Certificate of Education course who receives a score of E or
41	higher on a subject examination. A value of 0.3 full-time



42 equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each 43 student who receives an Advanced International Certificate of Education diploma. Such value shall be added to the total full-44 45 time equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 46 9 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year. Each school district 47 must allocate 100 percent of the funds received for Advanced International Certificate of Education instruction to the 48 49 program that generates such funds. Funds allocated in accordance 50 with this paragraph shall be expended solely for the payment of 51 administrative costs associated with the Advanced International 52 Certificate of Education Program and teacher bonuses. 53 Administrative costs shall include costs associated with 54 Advanced International Certificate of Education annual school 55 fees and examination fees and professional development for Advanced International Certificate of Education teachers. The 56 57 teacher bonus shall equal the proportionate value of the 0.16 or 58 0.08 additional funding per eligible student score minus 59 administrative costs, or \$50 per eligible student score, 60 whichever is greater. The teacher bonus in a school designated with a grade of "D" or "F" shall be an additional \$500 if any 61 62 one of the teacher's Advanced International Certificate of 63 Education students scores E or higher on an Advanced International Certificate of Education examination. The school 64 65 district shall distribute to each classroom teacher who provided 66 Advanced International Certificate of Education instruction: 67 1. A bonus in the amount of \$50 for each student taught by 68 the Advanced International Certificate of Education teacher in 69 each full-credit Advanced International Certificate of Education 70 course who receives a score of E or higher on the Advanced

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71	International Certificate of Education examination. A bonus in
72	the amount of \$25 for each student taught by the Advanced
73	International Certificate of Education teacher in each half-
74	credit Advanced International Certificate of Education course
75	who receives a score of E or higher on the Advanced
76	International Certificate of Education examination.
77	2. An additional bonus of \$500 to each Advanced
78	International Certificate of Education teacher in a school
79	designated with a grade of "D" or "F" who has at least one

103 (o) Calculation of additional full-time equivalent 104 membership based on College Board Advanced Placement scores of 105 students.-A value of 0.16 full-time equivalent student 106 membership shall be calculated for each student in each Advanced 107 Placement course who receives a score of 3 or higher on the 108 College Board Advanced Placement examination for the prior year 109 and added to the total full-time equivalent student membership 110 in basic programs for grades 9 through 12 in the subsequent 111 fiscal year. Each school district must allocate 100 percent of 112 the funds received for Advanced Placement instruction to the 113 school that generates such funds. Funds allocated in accordance 114 with this paragraph shall be expended solely for the payment of 115 administrative costs associated with the Advanced Placement Program and teacher bonuses. Administrative costs shall include 116 117 costs associated with Advanced Placement examination fees and 118 professional development for Advanced Placement teachers. The 119 teacher bonus shall equal the proportionate value of the 0.16 120 additional funding per eligible student score minus 121 administrative costs, or \$50 per eligible student score, 122 whichever is greater. The teacher bonus in a school designated 123 with a grade of "D" or "F" shall include an additional \$500 per 124 student for the teacher's first four students who score 3 or 125 higher on an Advanced Placement examination. Each district must 126 allocate at least 80 percent of the funds provided to the 127 district for advanced placement instruction, in accordance with 128 this paragraph, to the high school that generates the funds. The
