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The Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 (Detert) recommended the following:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete lines 60 - 203  
and insert:  
the 0.16 additional funding per eligible student score minus administrative costs, or \$50 per eligible student score, whichever is greater. The teacher bonus in a school designated with a grade of "D" or "F" shall be an additional \$500 if any one of the teacher's international baccalaureate students scores 4 or higher on an International Baccalaureate examination. The school district shall distribute to each classroom teacher who provided international baccalaureate instruction:

36 Certificate of Education course who receives a score of E or  
37 higher on a subject examination. A value of 0.08 full-time  
38 equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each  
39 student enrolled in a half-credit Advanced International  
40 Certificate of Education course who receives a score of E or  
41 higher on a subject examination. A value of 0.3 full-time



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42 equivalent student membership shall be calculated for each  
43 student who receives an Advanced International Certificate of  
44 Education diploma. Such value shall be added to the total full-  
45 time equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades  
46 9 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year. Each school district  
47 must allocate 100 percent of the funds received for Advanced  
48 International Certificate of Education instruction to the  
49 program that generates such funds. Funds allocated in accordance  
50 with this paragraph shall be expended solely for the payment of  
51 administrative costs associated with the Advanced International  
52 Certificate of Education Program and teacher bonuses.

53 Administrative costs shall include costs associated with  
54 Advanced International Certificate of Education annual school  
55 fees and examination fees and professional development for  
56 Advanced International Certificate of Education teachers. The  
57 teacher bonus shall equal the proportionate value of the 0.16 or  
58 0.08 additional funding per eligible student score minus  
59 administrative costs, or \$50 per eligible student score,  
60 whichever is greater. The teacher bonus in a school designated  
61 with a grade of "D" or "F" shall be an additional \$500 if any  
62 one of the teacher's Advanced International Certificate of  
63 Education students scores E or higher on an Advanced  
64 International Certificate of Education examination. ~~The school~~

108 College Board Advanced Placement examination for the prior year  
109 and added to the total full-time equivalent student membership  
110 in basic programs for grades 9 through 12 in the subsequent  
111 fiscal year. Each school district must allocate 100 percent of  
112 the funds received for Advanced Placement instruction to the  
113 school that generates such funds. Funds allocated in accordance  
114 with this paragraph shall be expended solely for the payment of  
115 administrative costs associated with the Advanced Placement  
116 Program and teacher bonuses. Administrative costs shall include  
117 costs associated with Advanced Placement examination fees and  
118 professional development for Advanced Placement teachers. The  
119 teacher bonus shall equal the proportionate value of the 0.16  
120 additional funding per eligible student score minus  
121 administrative costs, or \$50 per eligible student score,  
122 whichever is greater. The teacher bonus in a school designated  
123 with a grade of "D" or "F" shall include an additional \$500 per
