Between lines 132 and 133, insert:

Section 2. Section 284.51, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

284.51 Public employer workplace safety.--

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(a) "OSHA" means the Occupational Safety and Health Administration in the United States Department of Labor.

(b) "Public employer" means any agency within state, county, or municipal government, including a school district, that employs individuals for salary, wages, or other remuneration.

(2) Effective June 30, 2013, all public employers must comply with OSHA general industry standards provided in C.F.R.
