Between lines 315 and 316

insert:

Section 8. Subsection (9) of section 790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

(12) A ~~No~~ license issued pursuant to this section may not ~~shall~~ authorize any person to carry a concealed weapon or firearm into any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05; any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station; any detention facility, prison, or jail; any courthouse; any courtroom, except that ~~nothing in this section would preclude~~ a judge may not be

14 precluded from carrying a concealed weapon or determining who
15 will carry a concealed weapon in his or her courtroom; any
16 polling place; any meeting of the governing body of a county,
17 public school district, municipality, or special district; any
18 meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof; any school,
19 college, or professional athletic event not related to firearms;
20 any school administration building; any portion of an
21 establishment licensed to dispense alcoholic beverages for
22 consumption on the premises, which portion of the establishment
23 is primarily devoted to such purpose; any elementary or
24 secondary school facility; any career center; any college or
25 university facility unless the licensee is a registered student,
26 employee, or faculty member of such college or university and
27 the weapon is a stun gun or nonlethal electric weapon or device
28 designed solely for defensive purposes and ~~the weapon~~ does not
29 fire a dart or projectile; inside the passenger terminal and
30 sterile area of any airport, provided that no person shall be
31 prohibited from carrying any legal firearm into the terminal,
32 which firearm is encased for shipment for purposes of checking
33 such firearm as baggage to be lawfully transported on any
34 aircraft; or any place where the carrying of firearms is
35 prohibited by federal law. However, a licensee may not be
36 prevented from transporting or storing a lawful firearm in a
37 private vehicle for lawful purposes if the vehicle is otherwise
38 lawfully present. Any person who willfully violates any
39 provision of this subsection commits a misdemeanor of the second
40 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
