Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 15 - 22

and insert:

Section 1. Present subsection (12) of section 1009.22, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (13), and a new subsection (12) is added to that section, to read:

1009.22 Workforce education postsecondary student fees.—
(12) (a) Each community college board of trustees may establish a transportation access fee. Revenue from the fee, with the advice and consent of the student government, may be used only to provide or improve access to transportation services for students enrolled in the community college. The fee

14 may not exceed \$6 per credit hour. An increase in the
15 transportation access fee may occur only once each fiscal year
16 and must be implemented beginning with the fall term.

17 (b) Notwithstanding ss. 1009.534, 1009.535, and 1009.536,
18 the transportation access fee authorized under paragraph (a)
19 shall not be included in calculating the amount a student
20 receives for a Florida Academic Scholars award, a Florida
21 Medallion Scholars award, or a Florida Gold Seal Vocational
22 Scholars award.

23 Section 2. Present subsection (17) of section 1009.23,
24 Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (18), and a new
25 subsection (17) is added to that section to read:

26 1009.23 Community college student fees.—

27 (17) (a) Each community college board of trustees may
28 establish a transportation access fee. Revenue from the fee,
29 with the advice and consent of the student government, may be
30 used only to provide or improve access to transportation
