(i) The wholesale distribution of prescription drugs within a sealed medical convenience kit if:

1. The medical convenience kit is assembled in an establishment that is registered with the United States Food and

14 2. The convenience kit manufacturer is an authorized
15 distributor of record, as defined by 21 C.F.R. s. 203.3, for the
16 manufacturer of the specific drugs contained within the kit; and

18 a. Intravenous solutions intended for the replenishment of
