Section 17. Present subsections (32) through (54) of section 499.003, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (33) through (55), respectively, and a new subsection (32) is added to that section, to read:

9 499.003 Definitions of terms used in this part.—As used in this part, the term:

(32) "Medical convenience kit" means packages or units that contain combination products as defined in 21 C.F.R. s. 3.2(e)(2).
