Section 1. Section 553.875, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

553.875 Agreements for property repairs related to reactive drywall.-In the absence of government laws, rules, or ordinances establishing standards in the applicable jurisdiction for making repairs due to problems arising from the use of reactive drywall in improvements to real property, a property owner or a condominium association authorized under chapter 718 to enter into contracts on behalf of unit owners, and a condominium developer or licensed contractor, or any combination of such persons or entities, may agree to specific measures to effect such repairs. If these measures are completed pursuant to the agreement, the condominium association, property owner, subsequent owners, and their successors in interest will not

have a cause of action against the condominium developer or

contractor for damage to the property arising from the prior use of reactive drywall or from the repairs, regardless of the later adoption of government laws, rules, or ordinances establishing repair standards in the applicable jurisdiction which take effect after the date of the agreement. As used in this section, the term "reactive drywall" means drywall or similar materials that are contaminated with substances that cause the corrosion of metals or emit sulfurous compounds.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
