Subsection (1) of section 465.0276, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 465.0276 Dispensing practitioner.--(1) (a) A person may not dispense medicinal drugs unless licensed as a pharmacist or otherwise authorized under this chapter to do so, except that a practitioner authorized by law to prescribe drugs may dispense such drugs to her or his patients in the regular course of her or his practice in compliance with this section. A practitioner registered under this section may not dispense more than a 72-hour supply of a controlled substance

21 listed in Schedule II, Schedule III, or Schedule IV as provided 22 in s. 893.03. This paragraph does not apply to controlled 23 substances dispensed in the health care system of the Department 24 of Corrections.
