An act relating to a review of the Department of State under the Florida Government Accountability Act; reenacting s. 20.10(2)(c), F.S., relating to the Division of Corporations within the department; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, ss. 11.901-11.920, Florida Statutes, the Florida Government Accountability Act, subjects the Division of Corporations within the Department of State to a sunset review process in order to determine whether the agency should be retained, modified, or abolished, and

WHEREAS, the Department of State produced a report providing specific information, as enumerated in s. 11.906, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the report, the Joint Legislative Sunset Committee and committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives assigned to act as sunset review committees reviewed the report and requested studies by the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability, and

WHEREAS, based on the report, studies by the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability, and public input, the legislative sunset review committees made recommendations on the abolition, continuation, or reorganization of the Division of Corporations within the Department of State; on the need for the functions performed by this division; and on the consolidation, transfer, or reorganization of programs within the Department of State under review, NOW, THEREFORE,
