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The Policy and Steering Committee on Ways and Means (Peaden) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 40 and 41
insert:

Section 2. (1) The Division of State Group Insurance within the Department of Management Services shall establish a state employee health clinic pilot program for the 2011 plan year.

(2) The Division of State Group Insurance, through a competitive procurement pursuant to the chapter 287, Florida Statutes, shall select a vendor that shall establish and manage at least one full-scope health and wellness clinic providing members of the State Group Health Insurance Program access to



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13 the following services:

14 (a) Primary care services, including walk-in and
15 consultative appointments for full-scope clinic services,
16 including urgent care;

17 (b) Occupational health services, including return-to-work
18 planning, new hire and emergent drug screening, and injury care;

19 (c) Immunizations, including vaccines and flu shots; and

20 (d) Wellness services, including online tools and services,
21 health risk assessment and recommendations, health mailings,
22 health fairs, wellness screenings, and on-site education.

23 (3) The vendor shall provide any start-up costs associated
24 with the pilot program and shall employ the staff and manage the
25 clinic, subvendors, and integrated services providers.

26 (4) The pilot program shall commence no later than January
27 1, 2011. By February 1, 2012, the Department of Management
28 Services shall submit an evaluation of the pilot program to the
29 Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the
30 House of Representatives. The report must evaluate the extent to
31 which the vendor has:

32 (a) Implemented comprehensive services for state employees;

33 (b) Leveraged group purchasing power in order to enable
34 convenient access to full-scope services;

35 (c) Distributed health and wellness information and health
36 education materials; and

37 (d) Ensured consistent quality standards.

38 (5) The term of the contract shall be for only the 2011
39 plan year.

60 specified date; providing that the term of the
61 contract be for only the 2011 plan year; providing an
62 effective date.
