A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the offense of procuring a person for prostitution; amending s. 796.03, F.S.; providing that a person who is 18 years of age or older commits a felony of the first degree if the victim of such offense is 16 years of age or younger and is 5 or more years younger than the person committing the violation; providing criminal penalties; amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; conforming a cross-reference; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 796.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

796.03 Procuring person under age of 18 for prostitution.-

(1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person who procures for prostitution, or causes to be prostituted, any person who is under the age of 18 years commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

(2) A person 18 years of age or older who procures for prostitution, or causes to be prostituted, any person who is 16 years of age or younger and who is 5 or more years younger than the person committing the violation commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

Section 2. Paragraph (g) of subsection (3) of section 921.0022, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
