19	cellular telephone. As used in this section, the term "cellular
20	telephone" has the same meaning as in s. 817.4821, Florida
21	Statutes.
22	(2) This section does not prohibit the use of a cellular
23	telephone for safety or law enforcement purposes if the use is
24	approved by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
25	(3) A violation of this section is a noncriminal traffic
26	infraction, punishable as a nonmoving violation as provided in
27	chapter 318, Florida Statutes. However, this section may be
28	enforced by a state or local law enforcement agency only as a
29	secondary action when the operator of a motor vehicle has been
