A bill to be entitled

An act relating to assessments for grade level assignment; requiring that the Department of Education adopt assessments for grade level assignment of a student who attended a private school or home school and who is transferring to or enrolling in public school; requiring that the assessments be based upon state-adopted grade level standards; requiring that each school district administer the assessments for grade level assignment; requiring that the assessments provide objective data pertaining to each student's readiness for the appropriate grade level and the student's progress in attaining performance standards; requiring that parents allow for their child to be assessed regardless of the date of enrollment during the school year; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Assessments for grade level assignment of</u> private school or home school students.—

(1) The Department of Education shall adopt assessments in order to determine the grade level placement of any student who attended a private school or home school in the previous school year and who is transferring to or enrolling in a public school.

The assessments must be based upon state-adopted grade level standards. Each school district shall administer the assessments for grade level assignment to any student who is transferring from a private school or home school to a public school or

enrolling in a public school before the student is enrolled in
grades 1 through 8.

- (2) The assessments for grade level assignment must provide objective data pertaining to each student's readiness for the grade level that he or she is to be enrolled in public school and the student's progress in attaining the performance standards adopted by the department.
- (3) Each parent who enrolls his or her child in a public school and whose child was enrolled in a private school or home school in the previous school year must allow the child to be assessed for grade level assignment regardless of the date of enrollment during the school year.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
