4. A local government may not deny a building permit based solely on the presence of petroleum contamination for any construction, repairs, or renovations performed in conjunction with tank upgrade activity in an existing retail fuel facility. Such facility must have been fully operational prior to the request for the building permit and any construction, repairs, or renovations must be performed by a licensed contractor. All building permits and any construction, repairs, or renovations



performed in conjunction with such permits must comply with the applicable provisions of chapters 489 and 553.
