<p>Section: 06</p> <p>On Page: 283</p> <p>Spec App: 2213</p>	<p><u>EXPLANATION:</u></p> <p>This amendment restores funding for the School Readiness program that was reduced from recurring general revenue. The amendment provides \$3,112,087 in nonrecurring funds from the Special Employment Security Administration Trust Fund. This will restore the funding for School Readiness to the current-year level. It will allow the state to draw \$3.8 million in federal funds and will restore 1,728 school readiness program slots.</p>
