12	households lack sufficient money to put food on the table and
13	are currently receiving food stamp assistance, and, on any given
14	night, there are about 57,000 Floridians without homes for

16	WHEREAS, in 1973 The Florida Bar, working with then-
17	Governor Reuben Askew, formed Florida Legal Services to expand
18	the availability of civil legal assistance to the poor in
19	Florida, and
20	WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has recognized the
21	importance of civil legal assistance to the poor and the
22	improvement of access to justice by passage of the Florida
23	Access to Civil Legal Assistance Act, and
24	WHEREAS, today there are 31 legal aid programs and 480
25	attorneys serving the residents of the state's 67 counties, and
26	each year the legal needs of more than 98,000 Florida families
27	are addressed by these programs, and
28	WHEREAS, legal aid attorneys and their support staff
29	protect the most vulnerable Florida residents from continued
