5 Section 2. Paragraphs (rrr) through (uuu) are added to
6 subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

7 320.08056 Specialty license plates.-

8 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be
9 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

10 (rrr) I Believe license plate, \$25.

11 (sss) Preserving the Past license plate, \$25.

12 (ttt) Trinity license plate, \$25.

13 (uuu) Children First license plate, \$25.

14 Section 3. Subsections (70) through (73) are added to
15 section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

16 320.08058 Specialty license plates.-

17 (70) I BELIEVE LICENSE PLATES.—Notwithstanding s.
18 320.08053(1)(b) and (c), the department shall develop an I
19 Believe license plate as provided in this section.

20 (a) I Believe license plates must bear the colors and
21 design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must
22 appear at the top of the plate, and the words "I Believe" must
23 appear at the bottom of the plate.

24 (b) The department shall retain the first \$60,000 of
25 annual use fees received from the sale of the plates.
26 Thereafter, the annual use fees shall be distributed to Faith in
27 Teaching, Inc., which may retain all of such revenue until the
28 startup costs to develop and establish the license plate program
29 have been recovered. Thereafter, Faith in Teaching, Inc., may
30 use the proceeds as follows:

31 1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to
32 fund the administrative, promotion, and marketing costs of the
33 license plate program.

34 2. The remainder shall be used to fund activities,
35 programs, and projects that promote faith-based education for
36 youth within the state.

37 (71) PRESERVING THE PAST LICENSE PLATES.—

38 (a) The department shall develop a Preserving the Past
39 license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear
40 the colors and design approved by the department. The word
41 "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words
42 "Preserving the Past" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

43 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Toomey
44 Foundation for the Natural Sciences, Inc., which shall retain 50

45 percent of the proceeds until the startup costs to develop and
46 establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the
47 proceeds shall be used as follows:

48 1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to

51 2. The remaining fees shall be used by the foundation to
52 acquire, manage, and preserve properties that are of scientific
53 importance to paleontologists, archeologists, or geologists for

56 (72) TRINITY LICENSE PLATES.—

57 (a) The department shall develop a Trinity license plate
58 as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and
59 design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must
60 appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Sunshine State"
61 must appear at the bottom of the plate.

62 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Toomey
63 Foundation for the Natural Sciences, Inc., which shall retain 50
64 percent of the proceeds until the startup costs to develop and
65 establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the
66 proceeds shall be used as follows:

67 1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to
68 fund the administrative, promotion, and marketing costs of the
69 license plate program and the foundation.

70 2. The remaining fees shall be used by the foundation to
71 support educational, research, and scientific activities in this

74 (73) CHILDREN FIRST LICENSE PLATES.-

75 (a) The department shall develop a Children First license
76 plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the
77 colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida"
78 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Children
79 First" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

80 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Children
81 First Florida, Inc., which shall retain all proceeds until the
82 startup costs to develop and establish the plates have been
83 recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:

84 1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to
85 administer the license plate program and to promote and market
86 the license plates.

87 2. The remaining fees shall be used by Children First
88 Florida, Inc., to fund public schools in this state, including
89 teacher salaries.

90 Section 4. Section 320.08069, Florida Statutes, is created
91 to read:

92 320.08069 Motorcycle In God We Trust specialty license
93 plates.-

94 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 320.08053, the
95 department shall develop a reduced-dimensions In God We Trust
96 specialty license plate for display on motorcycles.

97 (2) The department shall issue the plate to the owner or
98 lessee of any motorcycle upon request and payment of the
99 appropriate license taxes and fees.

100 (3) Each request must be made annually to the department,
101 accompanied by the following taxes and fees:

102 (a) The license tax required under s. 320.08.

103 (b) A license plate fee as required by s. 320.06(1)(b).

104 (c) A processing fee of \$2.

105 (d) A license plate annual use fee of \$30.

106 (4) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the In God
107 We Trust Foundation, Inc., which shall expend the funds as
108 provided in s. 320.08058(67), except that the foundation may
109 retain a maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds from the sale of
110 the license plate for the costs of administration, promotion,
111 and marketing of the plates.

112 (5) If an owner or lessee to whom the department has
113 issued a license plate acquires a replacement vehicle within the
114 owner's registration period, the department must authorize a
115 transfer of the specialty license plate to the replacement
116 vehicle in accordance with s. 320.0609. The annual use fee or
117 processing fee may not be refunded.

118 (6) The license plate shall be 4 inches wide by 7 inches
119 long and incorporate a red, white, and blue color scheme
120 approved for the In God We Trust plates authorized in s.
121 320.08058(67) and may bear the imprint of numerals from 1 to
122 999, inclusive, capital letters "A" through "Z," or a
123 combination thereof. The department shall determine the maximum
124 number of characters, including numerals and letters. The word
125 "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate.
