(uuu) Children First license plate, \$25.
Section 3. Subsections (70) through (73) are added to section 320.08058 , Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08058 Specialty license plates.-

(70) I BELIEVE LICENSE PLATES.-Notwithstanding s. 320.08053(1)(b) and (c), the department shall develop an I Believe license plate as provided in this section.
(a) I Believe license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "I Believe" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The department shall retain the first $\$ 60,000$ of annual use fees received from the sale of the plates. Thereafter, the annual use fees shall be distributed to Faith in Teaching, Inc., which may retain all of such revenue until the startup costs to develop and establish the license plate program have been recovered. Thereafter, Faith in Teaching, Inc., may use the proceeds as follows:

1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to fund the administrative, promotion, and marketing costs of the license plate program.
2. The remainder shall be used to fund activities, programs, and projects that promote faith-based education for youth within the state.
(71) PRESERVING THE PAST LICENSE PLATES.-
(a) The department shall develop a Preserving the Past license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Preserving the Past" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Toomey Foundation for the Natural Sciences, Inc., which shall retain 50 084477

(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Toomey Foundation for the Natural Sciences, Inc., which shall retain 50 percent of the proceeds until the startup costs to develop and establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:
3. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to fund the administrative, promotion, and marketing costs of the license plate program and the foundation.
4. The remaining fees shall be used by the foundation to support educational, research, and scientific activities in this

state, including the distribution of funds to qualified entities in furtherance of the stated purposes of the foundation.
(73) CHILDREN FIRST LICENSE PLATES.-
(a) The department shall develop a Children First license plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Children First" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Children First Florida, Inc., which shall retain all proceeds until the startup costs to develop and establish the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the proceeds shall be used as follows:

1. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds may be used to administer the license plate program and to promote and market the license plates.
2. The remaining fees shall be used by Children First Florida, Inc., to fund public schools in this state, including teacher salaries.

Section 4. Section 320.08069 , Florida Statutes, is created to read:
320.08069 Motorcycle In God We Trust specialty license plates.-
(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 320.08053, the department shall develop a reduced-dimensions In God We Trust specialty license plate for display on motorcycles.
(2) The department shall issue the plate to the owner or lessee of any motorcycle upon request and payment of the appropriate license taxes and fees.

(3) Each request must be made annually to the department, accompanied by the following taxes and fees:
(a) The license tax required under s. 320.08.
(b) A license plate fee as required by s. $320.06(1)(b)$.
(c) A processing fee of \$2.
(d) A license plate annual use fee of $\$ 30$.
(4) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the In God We Trust Foundation, Inc., which shall expend the funds as provided in s. $320.08058(67)$, except that the foundation may retain a maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds from the sale of the license plate for the costs of administration, promotion, and marketing of the plates.
(5) If an owner or lessee to whom the department has issued a license plate acquires a replacement vehicle within the owner's registration period, the department must authorize a transfer of the specialty license plate to the replacement vehicle in accordance with s. 320.0609. The annual use fee or processing fee may not be refunded.
(6) The license plate shall be 4 inches wide by 7 inches long and incorporate a red, white, and blue color scheme approved for the In God We Trust plates authorized in s. 320.08058(67) and may bear the imprint of numerals from 1 to 999, inclusive, capital letters "A" through "Z," or a combination thereof. The department shall determine the maximum number of characters, including numerals and letters. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate.
