(3) The Credit Acceleration Program (CAP) is created for the purpose of allowing a secondary student to earn high school credit in a course that requires a statewide, standardized end-of-course assessment under s. 1008.22(3)(c) or a standardized end-of-course assessment under s. 1008.222, if the student attains a specified score on the assessment. Notwithstanding s. 1003.436, a school district shall award course credit to a student who is not enrolled in the course, or who has not



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13 completed the course, if the student attains a score indicating
14 satisfactory performance, as defined in s. 1008.22(3)(c)5., on
15 the corresponding standardized end-of-course assessment or a
16 passing score on a standardized assessment under s. 1008.222.
17 The school district shall permit a student who is not enrolled
18 in the course, or who has not completed the course, to take the
19 standardized end-of-course assessment during the regular
20 administration of the assessment.
