(a) The Commissioner of Education shall analyze the content and

9 under the Industry Certified Funding List, pursuant to rules

10 adopted by the State Board of Education, including, but not

11 limited to, grade 10 FCAT Mathematics retakes until such retakes

12 are discontinued pursuant to subsection (9), the PSAT, the PLAN,

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13	the SAT, the ACT, and the College Placement Test, to assess if
14	equivalent scores for end-of-course assessment scores can be
15	determined for passage of an end-of-course assessment. When
16	content alignment and equivalent scores can be determined, the
17	Commissioner of Education shall adopt those scores as meeting
18	the requirement to pass the end-of-course assessment and as
19	being sufficient to achieve additional purposes as determined by
20	rule. Each time that assessment content or scoring procedures
21	change for an end-of-course assessment or for a high school
22	achievement test or a national industry certification test under
23	the Industry Certified Funding List, pursuant to rules adopted
24	by the State Board Education, for which an equivalent score is
25	determined, new equivalent scores must be determined.

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
