Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 316.305, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

316.305 Use of cellular telephones in school zones; enhanced penalties.—

- (1) A person may not operate a cellular telephone while driving a motor vehicle in a school zone in this state.
- (2) A violation of this section is a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a nonmoving violation as provided in chapter 318, except that the violator shall pay a fine that is double the amount provided in chapter 318 for a nonmoving violation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
