Delete lines 14 - 33
and insert:

316.29545 Window suncreening exclusions; medical exemption; certain law enforcement vehicles and private investigative service vehicles exempt.-

(1) The department shall issue medical exemption certificates to persons who are afflicted with Lupus, any autoimmune disease, or other similar medical conditions which require a limited exposure to light, which certificates shall entitle the person to whom the certificate is issued to have
