The Committee on Transportation (Baker) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 179 and 180
insert:

Section 9. Subsection (3) of section 322.05, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

322.05 Persons not to be licensed.—The department may not issue a license:

(3) To a person who is at least 16 years of age but who is under 18 years of age, unless:

(a) The person provides proof of successfully completing a basic driver improvement course that meets the requirements of

13 s. 318.1451 within 3 months before the date the person applied
14 for licensure; and

15 (b) The parent, guardian, or other responsible adult
16 meeting the requirements of s. 322.09 certifies that he or she,
17 or another licensed driver 21 years of age or older, has
18 accompanied the applicant for a total of not less than 50 hours'
19 behind-the-wheel experience, of which not less than 10 hours
20 must be at night. This paragraph subsection is not intended to
21 create a private cause of action as a result of the
22 certification. The certification is inadmissible for any purpose
23 in any civil proceeding.

25 Paragraph (a) does not apply to a person who has been licensed
26 in any other jurisdiction or who has satisfactorily completed a
27 Department of Education driver's education course offered
28 pursuant to s. 1003.48.

29 Section 10. Subsection (4) of section 318.1451, Florida
30 Statutes, is amended to read:

31 318.1451 Driver improvement schools.-

32 (4) (a) In addition to a regular course fee, an assessment
33 fee in the amount of \$2.50 shall be collected by the school from
34 each person who elects to attend a course, as it relates to ss.
35 318.14(9), 322.0261, 322.291, and 627.06501, which shall be
36 remitted to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
37 and deposited in the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund to
38 administer this program and to fund the general operations of
39 the department.

40 (b) In addition to a regular course fee, an assessment fee
41 in the amount of \$2.50 shall be collected by the school from

42 each person who attends a course, as it relates to 322.05(3),
43 which shall be remitted to the Department of Highway Safety and
44 Motor Vehicles and deposited in the Highway Safety Operating
45 Trust Fund to fund the signage and educational requirements of
46 section 7 of this act.
