7 320.697 Civil damages.—Any person who has suffered 8 pecuniary loss or who has been otherwise adversely affected 9 because of a violation by a licensee <u>or motor vehicle dealer</u> of 10 ss. 320.60-320.70, notwithstanding the existence of any other 11 remedies under ss. 320.60-320.70, has a cause of action against 12 the licensee <u>or motor vehicle dealer</u> for damages and may recover

13	actual damages therefor in any court of competent jurisdiction		
14	in an amount equal to 3 times the pecuniary loss, together with
