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Section 1. <u>The facts stated in the preamble to this act are</u> found and declared to be true.

Section 2. <u>The City of Hialeah is authorized and directed</u> <u>to appropriate from funds of the city not otherwise appropriated</u> <u>and to draw ten consecutive annual warrants in the amount of</u> <u>\$50,000 each, for a total settlement of \$500,000, pursuant to</u> <u>the settlement agreement, payable to Friedman, Rodman, & Frank</u> <u>Trust and Madonna Castillo, which sum is inclusive of costs and</u> Florida Senate - 2010 Bill No. SB 50

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13	attorney's fees as limited in accordance with s. 768.28, Florida
14	Statutes, as compensation for the injuries sustained by Madonna
15	Castillo due to the negligence of the City of Hialeah. The first

18	1, concluding with the final installment to be paid on July 1,
19	<u>2019.</u>
20	Section 3. The amounts paid by the City of Hialeah pursuant
21	to s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and the amount awarded under
22	this act are intended to provide the sole compensation for all
23	present and future claims arising out of the factual situation
24	described in the preamble to this act which resulted in the
25	injuries sustained by Madonna Castillo. The total amount paid
26	for attorney's fees, lobbying fees, costs, and other similar
27	expenses relating to this claim may not exceed 25 percent of the
28	amount awarded under this act.

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43	WHEREAS, on July 3, 1998, Madonna Castillo, a minor, was
44	swimming in the public pool at Milander Park in the City of
45	Hialeah, and
46	WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah managed and operated the pool
47	at Milander Park, and
48	WHEREAS, city employees allowed swimmers to be rowdy in and
49	around areas of the pool in which others were swimming, and
50	WHEREAS, the lifeguard on duty had abandoned his post, and
51	WHEREAS, while Madonna Castillo was standing in the pool
52	talking to her sister, Madonna Castillo was struck in the eye by
53	another swimmer, and
54	WHEREAS, as a result of the incident, Madonna Castillo
55	suffered total vision loss in her right eye and underwent two
56	surgeries, including the insertion of a microvalve to regulate
57	intraocular pressure, and
58	WHEREAS, Madonna Castillo's injuries will require the
59	eventual removal of her right eye and the insertion of a
60	prosthetic eye, and
61	WHEREAS, after a jury trial resulting in a verdict in favor
62	of Madonna Castillo, the City of Hialeah initiated appellate
63	proceedings, and
64	WHEREAS, the parties entered into a settlement agreement,
65	pursuant to which, on April 2, 2004, the City of Hialeah paid to
66	Madonna Castillo the sum of \$200,000, and agreed to support a
67	claim bill by the Legislature in the amount of \$500,000 in favor
68	of Madonna Castillo, NOW, THEREFORE,

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
