The certification criteria shall be based upon the amount and type 21 22 of materials recycled and the compliance record of the facility, 23 and may vary depending on the location in the state and the 24 available markets for the materials that are processed. Any 25 materials recovery facility seeking certification shall file an 26 application to modify its permit, or shall include a 27 certification application as part of its original permit application, which application shall not require an additional 28 29 fee.
