14 rubber materials, and mulch, are encouraged to report the amount 15 of materials they recycle to the county annually beginning 16 January 1, 2011, using the department's designated reporting format. Using the information provided, the department shall 17 18 recognize those private businesses that demonstrate outstanding 19 recycling efforts. Private businesses that do not report recycling rates to the department shall be recorded as having a 20 zero percent recycling rate. Notwithstanding any other provision 21 of state or county law, private businesses, other than certified 22 23 recovered materials dealers, shall not be required to report 24 recycling rates. Cities with less than a population of 2,500 and 25 per capita taxable value less than \$4,800 and cities with a per 26 capita taxable value less than \$30,000 are exempt from the 27 reporting requirement specified in this paragraph.
