 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 9 Section 1. Section 20.059, Florida Statutes, is created to
 10 read:

11 20.059 Travel expenses of state agency heads and other
 12 state officials; reporting requirements.-

13 (1) On September 1, 2010, and on a quarterly basis
 14 thereafter, the head of each state agency listed in subsection
 15 (2), each member of the Parole Commission, each member of the
 16 Florida Public Service Commission, and the executive director of
 17 the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission shall submit a
 18 report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the
 19 House of Representatives regarding any job-related travel
 20 expenses incurred by, and reimbursed to, the state agency head
 21 or official during the preceding quarter. The report shall
 22 provide information for each trip taken, including the purpose
 23 and justification for the trip; the amount of hotel expenses, if
 24 any; the distance traveled; the dates of the trip; the method of
 25 travel and related expenses; and the total amount of travel
 26 expenses reimbursed by the agency.
