9 (8) PRIVATE SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY AND OBLIGATIONS.—An
10 eligible private school may be sectarian or nonsectarian and
11 must:

12 (e)1. Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year and
13 thereafter, adopt a salary schedule for instructional personnel
14 and school-based administrators which compensates instructional
15 personnel and school-based administrators based on their
16 performance. Salary adjustments for instructional personnel and

17 school-based administrators must be based only on performance
18 demonstrated under s. 1012.34 or a nationally norm-referenced
19 test identified by the Department of Education. An eligible
20 private school may not use length of service or degrees held by
21 instructional personnel or school-based administrators as a
22 factor in setting the salary schedule.

23 2. Adopt a performance appraisal system that compensates
24 employees based on their performance. An eligible private
25 school, in determining the salary adjustments for instructional
26 personnel and school based-based administrators, must base each
27 employee's adjustment only on performance demonstrated under s.
28 1012.34 or a nationally norm-referenced test identified by the
29 Department of Education.

31 The inability of a private school to meet the requirements of
32 this subsection shall constitute a basis for the ineligibility
33 of the private school to participate in the scholarship program
34 as determined by the Department of Education.
