The Committee on Health and Human Services Appropriations (Peaden) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment

Delete lines 315 - 332 and insert:

(11) The council <u>may shall</u> award grants for cancer research through the William G. "Bill" Bankhead, Jr., and David Coley Cancer Research Program created in s. 381.922.

(12) (a) From funds appropriated to accomplish the goals of this section, up to $\frac{500,000}{250,000}$ shall be available for the operating costs of the Florida Center for Universal Research to Eradicate Disease.

13 (b) (a) Beginning in the 2010-2011 2009-2010 fiscal year and thereafter, \$50 million from 5 percent of the revenue deposited 14 15 into the Health Care Trust Fund pursuant to ss. 210.011(9) and 210.276(7) shall be reserved for research of tobacco-related or 16 cancer-related illnesses, subject to annual appropriations in 17 the General Appropriations Act, which may include funding for 18 19 the James and Esther King Biomedical Research Program and the William G. "Bill" Bankhead, Jr., and David Coley Cancer Research 20 Program; however, the sum of the revenue reserved pursuant to 21 22 ss. 210.011(9) and 210.276(7) may not exceed \$50 million in any 23 fiscal year.
