To bring about such 21 retention, the salaries for full-time instructional personnel at 22 the school shall be increased annually to the average of 23 comparable salaries, based upon academic qualifications and years of experience, in the school districts of Clay County, 24 Putnam County, St. Johns County, and Flagler County. The salary 25 26 schedule for instructional personnel at the school shall be 27 negotiated annually in accordance with chapter 447. This
