Subsection (4) of section 373.079, Florida 15 Statutes, is amended to read: 16 373.079 Members of governing board; oath of office; 17 staff.-(4) (a) The governing board of the district shall is 18 19 authorized to employ: 20 An executive director, ombudsman, and such engineers, (a) 21 other professional persons, and other personnel and assistants 22 as it deems necessary and under such terms and conditions as it 23 may determine and to terminate such employment. The appointment 24 of an executive director by the governing board is subject to approval by the Governor and must be initially confirmed by the 25 26 Florida Senate. The governing board may delegate all or part of 27 its authority under this paragraph to the executive director. 28 However, the governing board shall delegate to the executive Page 1 of 4
