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Section 2. Subsection (7) of section 196.1995, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

196.1995 Economic development ad valorem tax exemption.-(7) The authority to grant exemptions under this section expires will expire 10 years after the date such authority was approved in an election, but such authority may be renewed for additional another 10-year periods upon approval period in a referendum

An act relating to property taxation; amending s. 95.051, F.S.; tolling the statute of limitations relating to proceedings involving tax lien certificates or tax deeds by the period of an intervening bankruptcy; amending s. 196.1995, F.S.; providing that the authority of the governing body of a county or municipality to grant certain ad valorem tax exemptions may be renewed for multiple 10-year periods upon approval by referendum; amending ss. 197.102, 197.122,
