procedure, the county or municipality that created the district may merge or dissolve the district pursuant to the same procedure by which the independent district was created. However, for any independent district that has ad valorem taxation powers, the same procedure required to grant such independent district ad valorem taxation powers shall also be required to dissolve or merge the district. Two independent special districts with similar functions and elected governing boards may elect to merge into one independent special district upon the adoption of a resolution by each governing board and the receipt of approval at referendum by the residents of each district. Until such time as a special act codifying the merger is approved by the Legislature, each independent district shall be considered a subunit of the merged district and shall file all reports required by chapter 189 as separate districts. The merged district shall be governed by a five-member governing board beginning with the next general election after the merger, and the merged district shall be limited to legislatively granted authority, including the ability to levy taxes and collect revenues, within the boundaries of each subunit which was previously granted to the associated independent district by its special act.
