15 (5) ~~(4)~~ The proposed budget of a dependent special district
16 must shall be presented in accordance with generally accepted
17 accounting principles, contained within the general budget of
18 the local governing authority to which it is dependent, and be
19 clearly stated as the budget of the dependent district. However,
20 with the concurrence of the local governing authority, a
21 dependent district may be budgeted separately. The dependent
22 district must provide any budget information requested by the
23 local governing authority at the time and place designated by
24 the local governing authority.

25 (6) ~~(5)~~ The governing body of each special district at any
26 time within a fiscal year or within up to 60 days following the
27 end of the fiscal year may amend a budget for that year as
28 follows:-

29 (a) Appropriations for expenditures within a fund may be
30 decreased or increased by motion recorded in the minutes if the
31 total appropriations of the fund do not change.

32 (b) The governing body may establish procedures by which
33 the designated budget officer may authorize certain budget
34 amendments if the total appropriations of the fund is not
35 changed.

36 (c) If a budget amendment is required for a purpose not
37 specifically authorized in paragraph (a) or paragraph (b), the
38 budget amendment must be adopted by resolution.

39 (7) If the governing body of a special district amends the
40 budget pursuant to paragraph (6) (c), the adopted amendment must
41 be posted on the official website of the special district within
42 5 days after adoption. If the special district does not operate

43 an official website, the special district must, within a
44 reasonable period of time as established by the local general-
45 purpose government or governments in which the special district
46 is located or the local governing authority to which the
47 district is dependent, transmit the adopted amendment to the
48 manager or administrator of the local general-purpose government
