(7) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or any other law, the Attorney General may not enter into a contingency fee contract with a private attorney, or any other contract with a private attorney, if the purpose of such contract is to provide legal representation in, or legal support for, litigation challenging the constitutionality of federal health care reform legislation providing qualifying health care coverage for individuals. The Attorney General must rescind, within the terms of the contract, any current contract executed
