Remove lines 317-377 and insert:

Section 3. For the 2010 calendar year, an application for classification as working waterfront under s. 193.704, Florida Statutes, must be filed on or before July 1 instead of on or before March 1.

Section 4. The Department of Revenue may adopt emergency rules to administer s. 193.704, Florida Statutes, as created by this act. The emergency rules shall remain in effect for 6 months after adoption and may be renewed during the pendency of procedures to adopt rules addressing the subject of the emergency rules.

Section 5. <u>If any provision of this act or the application</u>
thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
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MDER /

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invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.

Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law and shall operate retroactively to January 1, 2010.
