29 the identity of the children of the victim is confidential and 30 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State 31 Constitution.

(2) (a) Portions of meetings of any domestic violence 32 33 fatality review team regarding domestic violence fatalities and 34 their prevention, during which confidential or exempt 35 information, the identity of the victim, or the identity of the 36 children of the victim is discussed, are exempt from s. 286.011 37 and s. 24(b), Art. I of the State Constitution. The closed 38 portion of a meeting must be recorded and no portion of the 39 closed meeting may be off the record. The recording shall be 40 maintained by the domestic violence fatality review team.

(b) The recording of a closed portion of a meeting is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

(3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset
Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand
repealed on October 2, <u>2015</u> 2010, unless reviewed and saved from
repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. <u>The Legislature finds that it is a public</u> <u>necessity to make exempt from public records requirements</u> <u>recordings of any portion of a closed meeting of a domestic</u> <u>violence fatality review team. Release of such recordings would</u> <u>compromise those discussions of the team members which took</u> <u>place during a closed meeting, thus negating the public meetings</u> <u>exemption.</u>
