Amendment No. 17 and shall be in an amount equal to 110 percent of the estimated 18 mitigation costs for wetlands and other surface waters affected 19 under the permit. For permitted activities which will occur over 20 a period of more than 3 years of mining operations, the initial financial responsibility demonstration shall be in an amount 21 22 equal to 110 percent of the estimated mitigation costs for wetlands and other surface waters affected in the first 3 years 23 24 of operation under the permit; and, for each year thereafter, 25 the financial responsibility demonstration shall be updated, including to provide an amount equal to 110 percent of the 26 27 estimated mitigation costs for the next year of operations under 28 the permit for which financial responsibility has not already 29 been demonstrated and to release portions of the financial responsibility mechanisms in accordance with applicable rules. 30

31 Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 378.901, Florida 32 Statutes, is amended to read:

378.901 Life-of-the-mine permit.-

(2) As an alternative to, and in lieu of, separate 34 35 applications for permits required by part IV of chapter 373 and 36 part IV of this chapter, any each operator who mines or extracts or proposes to mine or extract heavy minerals, limestone, or 37 38 fuller's earth clay may apply to the bureau for a life-of-the-39 mine permit. Nothing in this subsection limits or restricts the 40 authority of a local government to approve, approve with conditions, deny, or impose a permit duration different from the 41 42 duration of a permit issued pursuant to this section.
